Monday 17th April 2023 - Friday 26th May 2023 (5 weeks, 3 days)

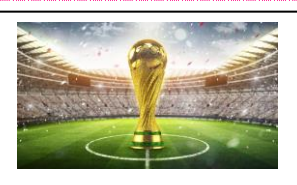
Dinner money amount = **£64.40**
