This year's Safer Internet Day will be celebrated next Tuesday, 9th February, with the following theme:

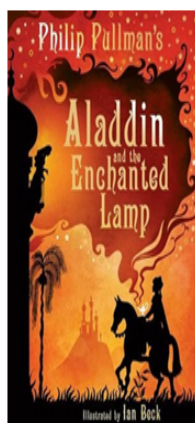
An internet we trust: exploring reliability in the online world.
