Year 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you name a suffix? What is a physical feature in our local area?
Year 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Who are 'The Big Five' in Africa? Where does the minute hand point for o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to?
Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What do you know about Roman catapults? Can you name 3 types of angles?
Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name some features of a non-fiction text. What is a habitat and how are local habitats being threatened?

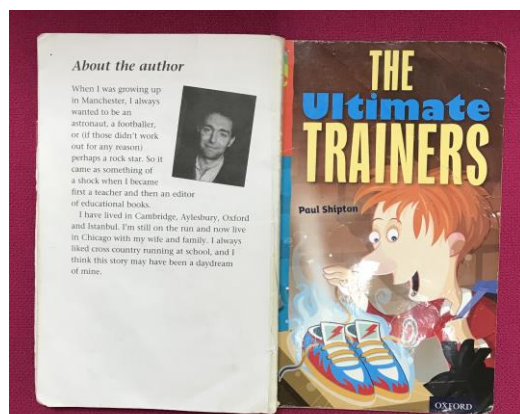

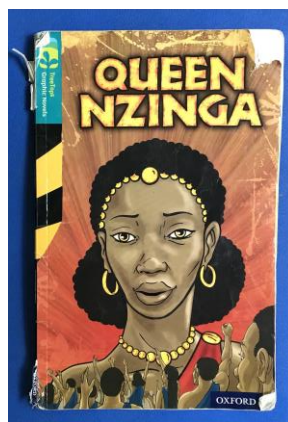
WE NEED EVERYONE TO LOOK AFTER SCHOOL
