Ladybridge Learning Conversations

Do you ever ask your child, 'What have you been learning at school today?', and they respond, 'Nothing'? Well, ask them these questions instead, and see what they say! We'll be sending home two weekly questions per year group to support your learning conversations at home. Look out for these on Class Dojo and here on the newsletter!

Reception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you blend the following sounds, to make the words; c-a-t ... d-o-g ... m-o-p ... b-a-g ... p-e-g? Can you count 10 objects, in a line?
Year 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you name the five senses? Which body parts do you use to: smell, hear, taste, touch and see?
Year 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you hold a balance on one leg for more than 5 seconds? Can you count in 3's up to 30?
Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you solve '326 + 8' using a number line? What is soil made up of?
Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name 3 structures of the digestive system. Can you write 23, 55 and 91 in roman numerals?
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What causes day time and night time? Why did Hatshepsut want to look more masculine?
Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In French, list the uniform that you wear. Is 4484 divisible by 2? 3? 4? 5? 9? 12?

ATTENDANCE

The good news is that our overall school attendance has been slowly improving each week, since the start of term - thank you to all of you that are making every effort to come to school every day. However, there are still some parents who are still not sending their children to school regularly. In light of this, we thought it was important that we clarify what consequences there are for families with poor attendance: **As soon as a child has 5 unauthorised days absence, the school will contact the council, who will issue a fixed penalty notice to both parents.** What happens to families who have received a fine but their attendance doesn't then improve?

- Parents will attend a meeting with Mrs Hall, the Deputy Headteacher, to sign an attendance contract.

- This contract is reviewed after 4 weeks.

- If attendance has improved, then the contract continues for another 4 weeks.

- If there has been no improvement, then school will begin prosecution procedures.

- This will result in either a £2500 fine or 3 months imprisonment.
