- All booked sessions will have to be paid for in advance (whether your child attends or not).

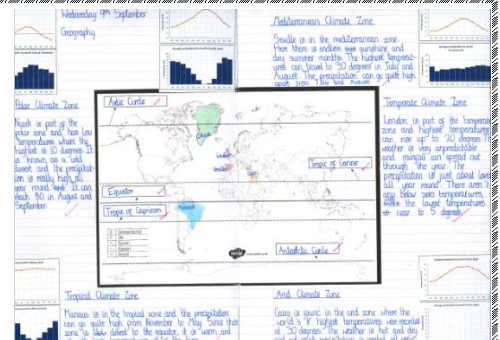
