TESCO COMMUNITY GRANT

A few weeks ago, Mrs Baker applied for a Tesco Community Grant. In the application, she outlined plans to develop our nature garden into a safer, stimulating and nurturing sensory garden so that children's mental health and well-being can flourish outdoors. This includes adding rich smelling flowers and plants and edible plants, natural sensory squares, wind chimes, mirrors, a water feature, outdoor musical instruments and a sensory swing. Our nature garden is already used as part of our curriculum. However, with these additions it ensures that our garden is accessible for all children in school. We want it to be a sanctuary, a place where children can safely and securely be in peace, tranquillity and nature. In the half term holidays, Mrs Baker was emailed to say that our application was successful and we have now been put forward to the customer vote in three Tesco stores: Westhoughton Exp (BL5 3JS), Horwich Extra (BL6 6JS) and Adlington (PR6 9LQ)
