Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you name <u>six</u> features of a persuasive leaflet? Can you name the <u>six</u> ingredients needed to make dough, and what each ingredient does?
Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is a podcast? Punctuate this piece of speech. Mirror, mirror on the wall who's the fairest of them all asked the queen.
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Between which two lines would you find the tropical rainforests around the world? Why do you think mammals have different gestation periods?
Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is a rectilinear shape? If a rectangle has a perimeter of 28cm and its length is 10cm, what is its area?
