

Each week, we focus on work undertaken by a different class. This week, it has been the turn of RB, who say ... we have been learning about the importance of recycling. In order for the children to understand this, we have been reading the story of 'Someone Swallowed Stanley', which follows Stanley's journey as a plastic bag in the ocean. We have focused on how plastic can be harmful to sea creatures and the children designed their own posters to raise awareness of recycling. The children also got the opportunity to explore different used materials, and we discussed how these need to be recycled properly.
