Year 4	 What is an algorithm? What foods do Jewish people eat to celebrate Passover?
Year 5	 What is bias and how does this affect historical sources? Can you answer the following question using long multiplication: 472 x 25 = ?
Year 6	 Can you name three components of blood? What three things are needed by the cells in our body, in order to survive?

<u>Class Focus</u>

Each week, we focus on work undertaken by a different class. This week, it was the turn of 1L who say ... we have been focussing on History. We have been learning about significant monarchs from the past: King Henry VIII, Queen Elizabeth I, King James I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II. We have looked closely at the lives of Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria, and what life was like when they ruled over England. Q. When is Chinese New year?

A. The **Chinese New Year** of **2022** will begin next week, on Tuesday 1 February, and the festival will last for 16 days. <u>2022</u> is the Year of the <u>Tiger</u>, according to the Chinese zodiac. The Chinese Zodiac, known as Sheng Xiao, is based on a twelve-year cycle, with each year in the cycle relating to an animal sign. These signs, in order, are the rat, ox, tiger, rabbit, dragon, snake, horse, sheep, monkey, rooster, dog and pig. It is calculated according to the Chinese lunar calendar.


