Wall of Excellence



Halal Survey Update

We had a really high number of responses to our halal questionnaire, and we have now reached the Local Authority's threshold for being able to offer a school menu with the 3 options of 'traditional', vegetarian and halal. So, what next...?

- The LA will be visiting the school after half-term to assess what changes need to be made in our kitchen (eg. layout, equipment, etc) and identify the costs for school. Last week, the Governors agreed to fund the changes needed.
- The school and LA will agree the plan, including a timeline, for any kitchen changes.
- The LA will create a '3 option' menu for school.
- Kitchen staff will be receiving training regarding the new procedures that will need to be introduced.

At this stage, it is unlikely that all the changes will be in place for September. We have been informed that the new menu will probably be ready to begin after October half-term. However, all the details will be finalised over the next few weeks.
