Ladybridge Learning Conversations

Do you ever ask your child, 'What have you been learning at school today?', and they respond, 'Nothing'? Well, ask them these questions instead, and see what they say! We'll be sending home two weekly questions per year group to support your learning conversations at home. Look out for these on Class Dojo and here on the newsletter!

Reception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is your class name? Can you make a pattern, using body percussion? E.g - clap, clap, tap.
Year 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is abstract art? Point to the following body parts: chest, shoulders, ankles, elbows and stomach.
Year 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you choose three random numbers and put them in order? What textured things can you find in your house to make rubbings?
Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you name the 3 types of natural rocks? When counting in 4s, is there a pattern in the ones column?
Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is the process of mummification? Can you name your body parts in French?
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What does the story of Ibrahim and the sacrifice of his beloved son tell us about Allah? Who was Tim Peake and what is he famous for?
Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What is inheritance? Name some characteristics that are inherited and some that are acquired.
