### Healthy Packed Lunches

New research has found that just 1 in 62 packed lunches meet food standards. The findings (which can be viewed via this link <https://bmjopen.bmj.com/content/10/1/e029688>) show that many children are still being sent to school with sugary drinks, crisps and chocolate bars. While the amount of sugar in packed lunches is declining, many contain foods that are still too high in sugar, salt or fat, and vitamin levels are falling.

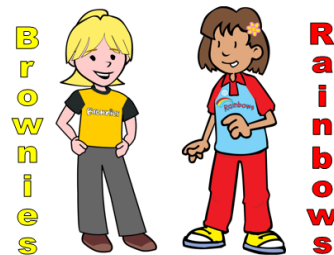
