^{*} Please ask your parents to return your completed forms either by post (address above) or hand-deliver into the box in the school foyer as soon as possible. Your parents will also need to bring to school your <u>original</u> passport or birth certificate, along with proof of your current address (eg, a recent utility bill). They should telephone the office staff on 01204 333646 to arrange a time when they can bring these documents into school.

Finally, we will be producing a list of staggered dates and times that shows exactly when each of our new Reception children will be starting with us in September. We will share this information with your parents before the end of the summer term. It's really important that all children join us on the date and time that gets allocated to them, as this will help you, and all your new Reception friends, settle into school as quickly as possible. Your new teacher will also be letting you know before the end of the summer term, which class you will be joining (it will either be Reception L or Reception B).
