The Chinese Zodiac, known as Sheng Xiao, is based on a twelve-year cycle, with each year in the cycle relating to an animal sign. These signs, in order, are the rat, ox, tiger, rabbit, dragon, snake, horse, sheep, monkey, rooster, dog and pig. It is calculated according to the Chinese lunar calendar.
