October Census Lunch 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

All of Key Stage 1 (Longleat, Archer and Salisbury Classes) and any Key Stage 2 children entitled to Free School Meals will be booked in for 'Pork Hotdog and Chips with Baked Beans' on Thursday 1st October 2026, as it is Census Day. The vegetarian option for lunch on this day is a 'Vegetarian Hotdog' with the same sides – any children who are vegetarian or cannot eat pork will be booked in for this option.

Dessert on this day is 'Warm Chocolate Brownie and Ice Cream'.

We will automatically book all KS1 and FSM children in for a lunch on this day, however, you are welcome to provide them with a packed lunch as a back-up if you would like to.

If you have a child who is following the main allergy free menu, they will be booked in for an allergy free version of this meal 'Allergy Free: Vegan Sausage in a Gluten Free Homemade Roll' and Chips with Baked Beans. Their dessert will be a 'Chocolate Cake'.

If your child has a bespoke allergy free menu, please call Mrs Thompson in the school office to discuss lunch options on this day.

If you would like to alter the selection made for your child, please log into your Parent Pay account before midnight on Tuesday 22nd September to do so, or contact the school office to arrange this.

If your child is not entitled to Free School Meals, you may still book them in for this special lunch, but will need to pay the usual fee.

Census Day takes places during the Autumn, Spring and Summer terms and schools are required to feed data to the government about how many children have received a school lunch. The amount of funding a school receives increases in line with the number of eligible pupils taking a free school meal on census day.
