Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we have had a brilliant response to our plans for a Year 6 residential in 2027 and the Skern Adventure trip will be going ahead as planned from Sunday 16th May to Wednesday 19th May 2027.

We are holding a meeting on September 4th 2025 at 14:45pm, to share information about the residential and answer any questions you might have.

To secure your child's place, an initial £50 non-refundable deposit needs to be paid by September 16th 2026. Please head to your Parent Pay account to make this payment. The remaining £253.49 of the Skern Adventure expense will be set up on Parent Pay for you to pay in instalments.

As coaches are often the most expensive part of any school trip, Larkhill Primary School PTA have very kindly agreed to donate £500 towards the cost of the coach for this trip. The final cost of the coach is variable dependent on the number of children who attend the residential – this will be the final instalment of your payments in February 2027.

The deadline dates for each payment are as follows:

£50 non-refundable deposit to be paid by 16/09/2026

£64 to be paid by 31/10/2026

£64 to be paid by 30/11/2026

£63 to be paid by 31/12/2026

£62.49 to be paid by 31/01/2027

Coach payment to be paid by 28/02/2027 – Amount TBC

If at any point you have concerns about paying by these deadline dates, please speak to Mrs Ball in the school office as soon as possible, so that we can try to help.

This trip is not part of our curriculum, and as such it is your responsibility to ensure payments are made on time. If you do not make the payments for your child's trip, we regret that they will not be able to attend.

We are very excited that so many of our Year 6 pupils will have the opportunity to take part in this experience, and we look forward to sharing more information with you and them throughout the school year.
