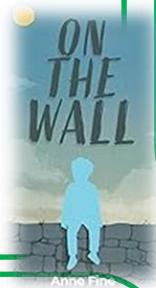




Wessex Class Newsletter Term 6



English In Writing, we will be refining all of the skills we need to meet the end of Key Stage 2 expectations. We will write some instructions using Alma and then we will watch a new animation called Wing to help us write a narrative. We will be reading the book *On the Wall* by Anne Fine and will be developing our love for reading by spending lots of time reading our own books.



Maths In Maths this term, we are revisiting a range of different areas to support our transition to secondary school. This will include:

- Place Value
- Four operations
- Fractions
- Angles
- Area
- Algebra



Geography Our topic this term is Geography and we will be learning about North America. We will explore the climate, physical and human geography as well as looking at trade routes.



Science In Science this term we will be learning about different scientists and inventors that are related to the areas of Science we have learnt about this year. This will give us lots of opportunities to explore, apply and consolidate our learning of Forces, Living Things and Materials.



What else are we learning?

Our work in **Computing** this term will focus on programming and we will be using Microbits to support this. In **PSHE**, we will be covering the unit *Changing Me*, where we will learn about the changes we will go through. We will also prepare for our transition to secondary school. In **DT**, we will be developing our woodwork skills by creating playground structures. Our **PE** sessions will start with swimming and then followed by striking and fielding games, including rounders. In **RE**, we will be learning to challenge stereotyping through understanding different Muslim interpretations. In **Music**, we will be practising our songs for our end of year show.



What do we need to remember?

We are having a real push on reading for pleasure this term and will be spending time each morning reading our own books. Please ensure children have their reading books in school every day. They should also be reading at home. We are going to see how many books we can read this term!

Children need to come bring their swimming kits in school every day for 3 weeks. Our forest school days will still be Friday.

This term we will be working hard to produce our Year 6 show- *The Boy, the mole, the fox and the horse*.
