### Year 3 Staffing Update – June 2026

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, Mrs Johnson-Motyl will be leaving Larkhill Primary School to take up a secondment maternity cover position within another White Horse Federation school. Whilst we will be sad to see her leave Year 3, we are incredibly grateful for the dedication, care and enthusiasm she has shown throughout her time with us, and we thank her for the strong foundations she has established with the children this year. We are pleased that this is a temporary secondment opportunity and that Mrs Johnson-Motyl will return to Larkhill once the maternity cover comes to an end.

I am delighted to let you know that Mrs Constable will be joining Larkhill on Monday 6th July 2026 and will become the Year 3 class teacher for the remainder of this term, before taking on the role of Year 4 class teacher from September. We are particularly pleased that Mrs Constable is able to join us before the end of term, as this will provide a valuable opportunity for a thorough and carefully planned transition.

Mrs Johnson-Motyl and Mrs Constable will work closely together, including a detailed handover and time spent together in the classroom. This will allow Mrs Constable to get to know the children, routines and curriculum, helping to ensure continuity and a smooth transition for the children in Stonehenge Class.

We see this early transition as a real positive for the children. Having the opportunity to build relationships with Mrs Constable before the summer holidays will help them feel confident and secure as they move into Year 4. We are confident that she will continue to build upon the strong foundations that Mrs Johnson-Motyl has established and support the children to thrive both academically and personally.

Mrs Johnson-Motyl's final day with the Year 3 class will be Thursday 9th July 2026. I know you will join me in thanking her for her commitment to the children and wishing her every success in her secondment role.
