





- It is based on the recognition that children learn best through play and active learning.



The Road To School

This tracker helps you and your child prepare for school.

Speaking & literacy

- I like to read stories & look at picture books
- I am able to talk about myself, my needs & feelings
- I am practising recognising my name when it's written down

Listening & understanding

- I am able to sit still and listen for a short while
- I can follow instructions
- I understand the need to follow rules

Writing skills

- I like tracing patterns & colouring in
- I enjoy making marks
- I am practising holding a pencil

Sharing & turn taking

- I can share toys & take turns
- I like playing games with others
- I like interacting with other children

Everyone starts school with different abilities - your teacher will help you progress at your own level.

Interest in the world & new activities

- I enjoy learning about the world around me
- I am interested in exploring new activities or environments
- I like asking questions

Counting skills

- I enjoy practising counting objects
- I like saying number rhymes & playing counting games
- I can recognise some numbers when they are written down

Going to the toilet

- I can go to the toilet on my own, wipe myself properly & flush
- I can wash and dry my hands without any help

A typical day in our Foundation Class...

- ▶ 8.45 Welcome and register.
- ▶ 9.05-9.20 Teaching Session
- ▶ 9.20-9.40 Snack and play time
- ▶ 10.40-11.30 - Child initiated learning
- ▶ 11.30-11.40 - Teaching Session
- ▶ 11.40-12.40 -Lunch
- ▶ 12.40 -Registration
- ▶ 12.40-13.00 -Teaching Session
- ▶ 13.00-14.20 - Child initiated play and small group activities
- ▶ 14.20 -14.35 - Teaching session
- ▶ 14.35-14.50 - Preparing for home time and story

- ▶ However the day remains flexible to suit the childrens' needs and interests.

Tapestry

- ▶ We will be using an online Learning Journey.
- ▶ We will set it up in September for your child.
- ▶ Parents get notifications to say when a new observation has been uploaded.

- ▶ We will require your consent for your child to feature in other children's photographs. When two children are tagged then the photo becomes pixelated however there are times when children may be seen in other photographs.

Select the pieces of uniform you would like to order. Name tapes are the best thing to use when labelling your child's clothing. They last longer than a sharpie.

Snack & Lunch Time



Snack Time

- ▶ Children receive a piece of fruit each day.
- ▶ Milk is available to the children as part of snack time. This milk is free of charge until your child turns 5. If you wish for your child to continue drinking milk then you will need to sign up to coolmilk.co.uk (Don't rush to do this as usually we have enough milk for everyone until the summer term) - We will advise you if you need to register with cool milk.

School Lunches/Packed Lunch

- ▶ All children in reception and key stage 1 are entitled to a universal free school meal.
- ▶ School meals are booked via Parent Pay. You will need your registration details before you can do this. These will be sent by the School office.
- ▶ There will be a paper menu for you to select your child's meals for the first couple of weeks.



School Lunches/Packed Lunch

- If you prefer you can send your child in with a packed lunch. Please make sure this is labelled on the outside. please keep these as healthy as possible.
- Don't overwhelm the children with too much choice in their packed lunch.

Administration



Parent Pay

- ▶ This is a platform that lets you preload money onto the site using a debit/credit card.
- ▶ The money can then be used to pay for trips and book clubs.
- ▶ This site is also used to book your child's school meals - please note meals need to be booked by midnight on Tuesday for the following week.
- ▶ The office will send out a registration letter with activation details

Pupil Asset Parent Portal

- ▶ This allows you to see and check details held by the schools management and information system.

It also allows you to see your child's:

- ▶ Attendance.
- ▶ Report absence.
- ▶ View school reports.
- ▶ Book parents evening.
- ▶ The office email you a link with instructions

Medical information and other matters



Other Matters...

Absence

- Any absence requires a telephone call to the school office by 9:30am (please note that messages can be left on the school answer phone or you can send a message via the Pupil Asset Parent Portal) This should be everyday that your child is off ill.
-
- If your child is off school due to D & V then they can return to school once they are clear for 24 hours after their last bout of D & V.



Other Matters...

Medical

- ▶ Inhalers and Epi pens can be kept in the class and administered when required.
- ▶ Medical/Dental appointments for children during school time will require you to show proof of the appointment where possible.
- ▶ Any prescribed medication can only be administered by prior arrangement with the school office and only if to be administered 4 times a day. A medical form will need to be completed.



Other Matters...

COVID-19

If your child or any member of the family experience symptoms - Please stay at home and isolate. Book a test and if it comes back as negative then your child can return. If it is positive then there will need to be a period of self isolation.



Other matters...

Collection

- ▶ If you wish for someone else to collect your child then you need to inform the school via the class teacher or school office in an emergency.
- ▶ The person collecting should be over 18.
- ▶ Drop off and Collection is from the classroom door which leads out on the playground.

Other Matters...

- ▶ A member of staff will always be available should you need to pass on information or have any questions.
- ▶ We run regular workshops throughout the year to support your child's development. We write a newsletter every week - These will be available to view on the website.

Other Matters...


- ▶ Please refrain from putting water bottles into book bags to help us protect books.
