


Archer Class Newsletter Term 5

This term, Year 1 will be using the story 'Dragon Post' to practise how to write a sentence using a full stop and how we can use an adjective to add some description to a noun. We are looking forward to using oral rehearsal before we write to help us see what a sentence sounds like before what it looks like.



Maths



The children will be securing their understanding of numbers to 100. They will be working on addition and subtraction within 20. We will also be looking at days of the week, months of the year and time. Please see the knowledge organiser below for more information.



Topic – Animals including humans

Throughout the topic, the children will be learning about what groups animals belong to – mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians. Using ICT, the children will research different animals, categorise them and find out how they have adapted to their environment. The children will also be learning about food chains and what the correct terminology is associated with this. A good fun topic all about animals.

What else are we learning?

We will be continuing to implement the key values we hold here at Larkhill with the children as this is having a positive effect on the children so far. Our jigsaw focus will be Relationships. More on this to follow.

In PE, the children will be outside learning how to play tennis which is always most fun! Please ensure that children's hair is tied back and earrings are removed for this session. Thank you.




What do we need to remember?
