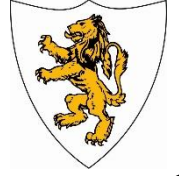




# Archer Class Newsletter



## Term 5



### English

We are continuing our writing journey with inspiration from 'Lost in the Toy Museum' and will write a setting description. Along with making sure we are consistently using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops we are learning the suffix – 'est' and dipping our toes into when to use an exclamation mark!

In the final two weeks we will be reading the book 'Tidy', planting seeds and writing a set of instructions on how to do so.

### Maths

This term we are adding and subtracting numbers to 20 using known facts, such as number bonds to ten and ways in which we can partition smaller numbers. We are trying not to use our fingers or counting on. Please look at the Knowledge Organiser which will explain this further (or ask at drop off/pick up 😊).

We will be starting our multiplication journey; doubling and halving, continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s, using arrays, grouping and sharing.

**Topic – The Amesbury Archer.** We will be learning about local history and a famous traveller – The Amesbury Archer. We are excited to find out more about who he was, where he came from and why we think he may have been here. The trip to Salisbury Museum will be a great trip to find out more and see his remains as well as other artefacts recovered from this time.

### What else are we learning?

During PE this term we will be doing Athletics. The children will learn what sprinting is, overarm and underarm throwing, jumping and finishing off the term with a mini Olympics.

Our jigsaw focus will be relationships, what makes a good friend and we will be thinking about people who are special to us.

In Computing, we are learning how to use a computer to write. In RE we will be learning to empathise with Jewish children by understanding what they do during Shabbat and why it is important to them.
