Where in the World?

KEY LEARNING- This term is all about the geography of the United Kingdom. The children will be learning the countries that make up the UK, their capital cities and main rivers. We will be using maps to develop an understanding of grid references and looking at symbols on maps.

What else are we learning?

Science: We are looking at states of matter and how they are different. We will also be linking this to the water cycle.

Art/ DT: Moving puppets with levers

PSHE: Celebrating Differences- recognising what makes us unique.

PE: Gymnastics & Basketball

Computing: Stop Animation. There is a programme called 2animate on Purple Mash which links to this.

Phonics: We are recapping the phase 3 phonics from Year 2.
