## English -



This term we will be reading

# Maths -



In Year 4, we will be covering lots of different topics. To start with, we will be learning about time and converting different units of time followed by area and perimeter of different shapes. Our last two units will be looking at position and direction and statistics.

As well as learning these topics in our main lessons we will be revising multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 and using the 4 operations to solve problems.

#### Science - Inventors

This unit we will be looking at different inventors who have made scientific discoveries linked to the topics we have covered this year. We will be refining our working scientifically skills and embedding the science knowledge we have learnt this year.

## What else are we learning?

**ART/ DT**- We will be creating our own structures and making volcanoes linking to our geography topic

**PSHE**- This term's topic is 'Changing me'. We will be learning about changes that happen socially, physically and emotionally as we grow.
