

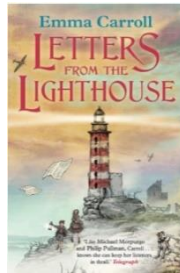


Silbury Class Newsletter Term 5



English

Our Reading and Writing this term will be inspired by the book 'Letters From The Lighthouse'. In Writing, we will write a letter using the relative pronouns 'which' and 'that', write a piece of dialogue that moves the action forward and re-writing a scene from the story.



Maths

In Maths this term, we will continue our fractions topic. We will be converting, adding, subtracting and multiplying proper and improper fractions.

Let's add ...

$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{1}{6} = \text{Can't do it!!}$$



What do you notice?



$$\frac{2}{3} + \frac{1}{6} = \frac{4}{6} + \frac{1}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$$

History- Our topic this term is called Crime and Punishment. We will be learning about how crime and punishment has changed throughout History, developing our understanding of time lines, dates and the use of sources of evidence.



Science- Our **Science** topic will be Forces. We will learn about different forces such as friction, gravity, air resistance and water resistance. We will also learn about different mechanisms such as levers, pulleys and gears.

What else are we learning?

Our work in **Computing** this term will focus on drawing vector drawings. In **PSHE**, we will be learning about relationships. We will build on our learning about mental health from last term, and we will discuss grief, love and online safety. In **Art**, we will be learning about shape and form to design our own architecture. Our **PE** sessions will be developing our understanding and skills within athletics. In **RE**, we will be learning to identify ways in which Muslims try to lead good lives and how their belief in Akhirah influences this. In **Music**, we will be developing our improvising skills and composing our own music.



What do we need to remember?
