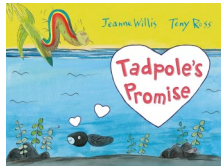

Year 1 | Summer



English

In English, we will be looking at the story 'Tadpoles Promise' by Jeanne Willis and Tony Ross. We will be internalising and imitating the story in our writing with a focus on adjectives, verbs and plural nouns. We will then link this to writing our own non fiction pieces based on the life cycle of a frog.



Maths

In maths, our focus is place value to 100. We will begin by counting and ordering numbers and learning how to partition numbers to 100, by introducing a place value mat (tens and ones). We will end the summer term by consolidating and highlighting misconceptions, ensuring the children are prepared for the next stage of their maths journey. .



History

During history this term we will be looking at the seaside and how holidays and time here has changed. We will be comparing times from the past and now and looking at the similarities and differences from 100 years ago.



Geography

This term we are investigating 'Our World' and we will be identifying the continents of the World and the seas and oceans surrounding. We will also discover many famous landmarks such as Stonehenge in England and the Alps mountain range.



Science

Our topic this term is plants and how they begin growing. As scientists we will conduct an experiment to find out what grows first, the roots or the stem and to see what happens if a plant doesn't have all the essentials for growth.



General Reminders

- Children should read every night to develop accuracy and fluency. An adult should then sign their home-school book to show this has taken place. We monitor and reward children for their efforts at home.
