Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will recall, we conducted a survey of parents/carers in the summer term as we wanted to hear your views about a range of important matters at Latton Green Primary Academy. It was a very valuable exercise – we really do want to know what you think about life at the school so that we can consider making changes if needed. Thank you to all those who did respond.

The results were very positive overall and I have provided them below, with our proposed response to particular statements that require the school to take actions. Some totals do not add up to 100% because of rounding up or down. The results are based on 62 responses and each response represents 1.6%

My child is happy at this school.	98%	2%	0%	We are delighted that so many parents/carers feel their child is happy at Latton Green.
My child feels safe at this school.	100%	0%	0%	We are delighted that all parents/carers feel their child is safe at Latton Green.
The school makes sure pupils are well behaved.	95%	5%	0%	Our Behaviour and Relationships policy is available on our school website if you would like more information on how the school manages behaviour.
Bullying is dealt with quickly and effectively.	27%	69%	3%	It would seem that the large majority of you don't know if bullying is dealt with effectively. This must be largely because your child has not experienced it. Bullying incidents at school are very low. When this does occur, we record each incident and follow our Behaviour and Relationships policy. The school has recently been awarded for excellence in challenging bullying through their work with Kidscape. We will be providing more information about this in our Sway newsletter this week.

If you feel the matter needs further support please then contact a member of the Senior Leadership Team who will be available on the playground each morning. The school has high expectations for my child.	90%	10%	0%	We are pleased that our high expectations for all children are recognised by parents/carers. Our high expectations are made clear through our Behaviour and Relationships policy with particular reference to our Rainbow of Respect.
My child does well at this school.	92%	8%	0%	We are pleased that so many of you feel that your child does well at Latton Green. This information is shared with parents/carers through termly progress reports, annual reports and termly consultation meetings.
The school lets me know how my child is doing.	90%	6%	3%	We are pleased that so many of you see this as a strength of Latton Green. This information is shared with parents/carers through termly progress reports, annual reports and termly consultation meetings.
There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.	90%	6%	3%	The school ensures all subjects that are part of the national curriculum are covered. Our termly curriculum letters will explain what is being taught in each of the subjects per term.

The school supports my child's wider personal development.	85%	11%	3%	The recent pandemic put a hold on many extracurricular events but as all restrictions have been lifted, we will be able to offer more educational visits as well as visitors to the school. Our after school club offer is also extending with the introduction of clubs led by external providers.		
I would recommend the school to another parent.	95% (Yes)		5% (No)	We are pleased that the majority of parents/carers would recommend Latton Green to another parent. We are happy to discuss any concerns that parents/carers may have that have led to the 5% of 'no' responses to this question.		

When it came to special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), 13% (8 out of 62 responses) of parents/carers who completed the survey said their child had SEND. We are delighted that 100% of these parents/carers who answered this question responded 'Yes' to the question 'My child has SEND and the school gives them the support they need to succeed.'
