KEY STAGE 3:

At Key Stage 3 we provide an overall figure for Progress and Achievement in the subject areas of ...

ENGLISH & MATHEMATICS

Progress and achievement in other subject areas is measured using a variety of subject based assessments.

At Key Stage 3 we measure progress in English & Mathematics using a functional skill, ForSkills Program & a range of additional assessments to establish a functional skills baseline. We measure progress at 6 weekly intervals. Some progress is teacher assessed but a significant proportion of progress is measured using a termly / exit ForSkills re-test approach.

In 2024.25 we introduced an Achievement Programme in the subject areas of English & Mathematics – This programme aims to provide some of our Key Stage 3 students with the opportunity to achieve a functional skills qualification in English and / or Mathematics. [The students accessing the Achievement Programme tend to be our longer term and more able students but this is not always the case and, if students demonstrate that they have the ability and motivation to sit a functional qualification they are supported to do so].

During the 2024.25 Academic Year ...

86 students accessed our English Forskills Tuition Programme

- 32% made EXPECTED or Better than Expected Progress.
- 32% made ABOVE EXPECTED or better than ABOVE EXPECTED progress.
- 16% made ACCELERATED progress.
- 17% of students achieved a qualification at an EXPECTED level of above

109 students accessed our Mathematics Tuition Programme ...

- 31% made EXPECTED Progress.
- 15% made ABOVE EXPECTED progress.
- 1% made ACCELERATED progress.
- 3% of students achieved a qualification at an EXPECTED level of above.

On average, 96 students accessed all 9 of our subject courses ...

- 47 % made EXPECTED Progress.
- 18% made ABOVE EXPECTED progress.
- 6% made ACCELERATED progress.

KEY STAGE 4:

At Key Stage 4 we now provide data indicating students' achievements in relation to two measures.

- Attainment 5 – Premier
- Attainment 5 – Preliminary
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During the 2024.25 Academic Year a total of 23 students attended our Key Stage 4 Education Programme[s].

ATTAINMENT 5 – PREMIER:

This measure of achievement records the number / percentage of students who are able to access our Key Stage 4 education programme for 3 or more terms and who achieve 5 or more level 1 qualifications or above in their academic & vocational studies. Under this achievement measure

- 5 Year 11 students gained 5 or more level 1 qualifications.
- 3 out of 14 Year 11 Pupil Premium students gained 5 or more level 1 qualifications

ATTAINMENT 5 – PRELIMINARY:

This measure of achievement records the number / percentage of students who are able to access our Key Stage 4 education programme for 1 term or more and are able to achieve 3 or more level 1 qualifications in their academic & vocational studies. Under this achievement measure

- 8 out of 23 Year 11 students gained 3 or more level 1 qualifications
 - 15 Year 11 students gained qualifications in maths and English at their working at levels.
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
