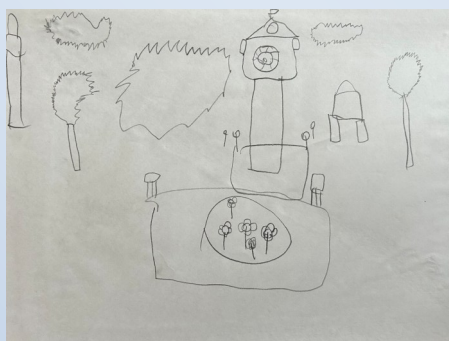
## Crewe Out Loud and Art Exhibition

School will also be closed to pupils on Friday 11th July 2025 due to an INSET Day.**

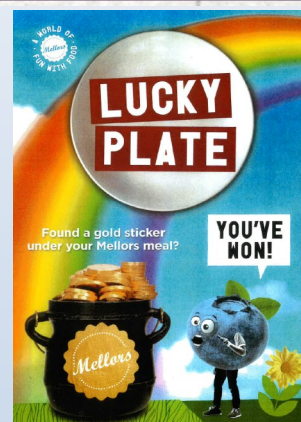
## School Meals
