## The Equality Duty

At Leighton Academy we have given 'due regard' to the Equality Act 2010 by meeting our specific duties to publish information and equality objectives. The Act put in place a number of duties for public bodies, including schools, to ensure that they have due regard to certain 'protected' groups. The protected groups are age, gender reassignment, disability, race, religion or belief, gender, sexual orientation and pregnancy or maternity. Cheshire East includes two further characteristics – carers and socio-economic disadvantage. In summary, all public bodies and schools must have due regard to the need to:

- 1. Eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment and victimisation.
- 2. Advance equality of opportunity between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.
- 3. Foster good relations between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.
