PE Assessment Strategies	To develop a focus on fundamental skills when assessing children's 'Physical Literacy' development in order to monitor progression and achievement in accordance to government guidelines. We have set up a PE twitter page so when class teachers do their second hour of PE they can tweet to show the progress of the children. CPD for the sports coach has focused on the effective use of assessment for learning so that students are every increasingly able to identify what skills they need to improve and then can make these improvements. This is contributing to the excellent rates of progression.
