High-quality texts: The Hole at the Bottom of the Sea. <u>As Scientists:</u>	Project Enhancements: As part of our topic we will be having a visit from Aqua Lease who will be bringing a rock pool into the classroom for the children to experience.
	We will study everyday materials including floating and sinking. We will study the habitat of the ocean and living things that call it their home. <u>As Computer Scientists</u> Using the laptops and ipads for research. <u>As Geographers:</u> We will learn about the oceans of the world and their locations. <u>As Historians</u> We will study significant people in the past.	Immersive space: We will create a reading corner with comfortable, rainbow seating and an ocean backdrop. We will hang clouds, birds and a rainbow from the ceiling.
Project Outcomes: In the project the children will use cross-curricula skills alongside BLP. At the end of the project we will be making a bag out of recycled material which the children will take home to reduce the use of plastic.
