I wanted to take this opportunity to share some details about the Autumn term. I have enclosed a staff list as well as a weekly overview of the lessons that will take place throughout the year.

ASD Provision

There have been some changes to the ASD Provision this year. Learners are now placed in classes according to their key stage (KS); This means that your young person is in KS3, learning with peers of a similar age and accessing subjects statutory for learners in years 7, 8 and 9. Their needs will of course be taken into consideration and lessons will be adapted where required.

This term's theme is The World Around Us and different aspects of this theme will be taught throughout the subjects as well as through class outings.

Curriculum

Maths, English and ICT will be taught daily. A focus on the functional aspects of these lessons will be maintained throughout the year, which will allow learners to develop their independent living skills and offer them the opportunity to transfer their mastered skills to different environments.

Communication

Communication sessions will be taught daily in line with EHCP targets as well as embedding any previous learned skills.
