It has been a fantastic start to the term; all pupils have settled and are enjoying learning together in Green Class.

I wanted to take this opportunity to share some details about the Autumn term. I have enclosed a staff list as well as a weekly overview of the lessons that will take place throughout the year.

ASD Provision

Learners are placed in classes according to their key stage (KS); this means that your young person is in KS4, learning with peers of a similar age and accessing subjects statutory for learners in years 10 and 11. Their needs will of course be taken into consideration and lessons will be adapted where required.

This term's theme is Healthy Living and different aspects of this theme will be taught throughout the subjects as well as through class outings.

<u>Curriculum</u>

Maths, English and Computing will be taught daily. A focus on the functional aspects of these lessons will be maintained throughout the year, which will allow learners to develop their independent living skills and offer them the opportunity to transfer their mastered skills to different environments.

Communication

Communication sessions will be taught daily in line with EHCP targets as well as embedding any previous learned skills.

Please drop off your young person at the Rectory Road gates by 8:20 am, ready for learning at 8:30 am. Learners will be ready to be collected at the Rectory Road gates at the end of the school day at 3:00 pm.
