We are excited to announce the launch of our updated **Walking Talking Mocks Programme** for 2026.

While previously focusing our Saturday Walking Talking Mocks on High Prior Attaining (HPA) students, we are shifting our philosophy to "Aim High." We believe every student should have access to the highest level of academic support; therefore, we are **opening these sessions to all Year 11 students** to help them reach their full potential.

What is a Walking Talking Mock?

These are teacher-led sessions where students work through a live exam paper at a set pace. The teacher deconstructs each question, highlighting key command words and demonstrating the exact techniques needed to secure the highest marks.

Our Key Objectives:

- Mastering Technique:** Showing students how to apply effective strategies to access top marks.
- Closing Gaps:** Identifying and intervening in specific areas where students may have gaps in knowledge.
- Maximising Outcomes:** Supporting every student in achieving the best possible results in their GCSEs.
