Dear Parents / Carers

I am writing to inform you that on Tuesday 27/09/22 and Wednesday 28/09/22, we will be running Cognitive Ability Tests (CATs) tests for year 7. CATs are assessments of developed abilities in areas known to make a difference to learning and achievement – namely verbal, non-verbal, quantitative and spatial reasoning – and provide teachers with an accurate analysis of potential student achievement. **Students cannot 'revise' for CATs tests**.

The schedule for the CATs tests is as follows:

Tuesday 27/09/22 Year 7 bands A and B

Period 1: Figure classification and figure matrices.

Period 2: Verbal reasoning skills. **Period 3:** Number sequencing.

Wednesday 28/09/22 Year 7 bands C and D

Period 1: Figure classification and figure matrices.

Period 2: Verbal reasoning skills.

Period 3: Number sequencing.

The CATs tests are completed in a specific way using pencil marks that are scanned through a machine. Please ensure your child arrives on time to school on Tuesday 27/09/22 and Wednesday 28/09/22, fully equipped for the tests with the following stationery:

- 2-3 sharpened pencils.
- 1 pencil sharpener.
- 1 rubber.
- 1 pen.
- A reusable water bottle (not single-use plastic)
