

Coronavirus: visitor agreement

On arrival at Little Ilford School, all visitors are required to take a lateral flow covid test, so please allow 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment. You also need to read and sign a copy of this agreement.

Our school will welcome visitors if:

The visitor is not at risk of bringing coronavirus into the school. Visitors should **not** come into school if they currently need to self-isolate, according to the <u>latest government guidance</u>, for example if they:

- Are displaying any coronavirus symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature, or a loss or change in their sense of taste and/or smell)
- Have received a positive coronavirus test result
- Have been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace

Visitors also need to follow the measures the school is taking to minimise the spread of coronavirus,

- Mask wearing is not compulsory around the school but we request that a mask is worn in public areas, the corridors and during meetings.
- Maintain a social distance from students and staff within the school where possible
- Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water for 20 seconds and sanitise your hands regularly there are various hand sanitisers around the school.
- Adopting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach

By signing this document, I understand and agree that when visiting the school:

- I confirm that I do not currently need to self-isolate, in line with the latest government guidance
- I will follow the school's hygiene practices (set out in the section above)
- I will engage with NHS Test and Trace, if I am to receive a positive coronavirus test result.

The information recorded below will help the school carry out rapid contact tracing, if asked to do so by NHS Test and Trace.
