Dear Parent / Carer

I would like to welcome all our students back to a new year at LIS. We have had a positive start to the year so far with good attendance and positive attitudes.

Feedback from the last couple of days has shown a few issues with uniform, so I would be grateful if you could remind your child of the uniform policy (which can be found on our website).

Although many of our students may not agree, wearing a uniform sets the scene; it places students in a 'working environment' mindset and helps them separate their home and school life. Over the years we have seen a link between students who regularly fail to wear full uniform with those who do not feel they want to be a part of the Little Ilford community - if this is the case, please do contact me to see how we can help.

In order to ensure our students are focused on their learning, makeup, false eyelashes or false nails are not allowed. Dyed hair or braids that are not of natural hair colour, are not allowed. We understand these do cost money to remove so please ensure your child has these removed before coming to school.

Just a reminder, blazers are compulsory but jumpers are not. In the hot weather we have given students permission to remove their blazer once in school, however they do need to bring it to school and wait for the message to be shared. Students who are uncomfortable taking their jumper off should see the safeguarding team who will discuss their concerns with them.

If you are struggling financially to supply your child with the correct uniform please let us know, we have pre-loved items and we have a hardship fund that may be able to support.
