Year 11 - GCSE grades

The school has had to create a Centre Policy for the allocation of grades in year 11. To do this, we have used the template produced by Ofqual. Part of this policy makes clear that teachers should not share grades with students in advance of the GCSE results day on Thursday 12th of August. We will be sharing details of the assessments that have been used to arrive at the results in each subject shortly, along with how to raise objections and what the appeals process will be. It's really important to say that the rules are clear that any undue pressure put on teachers by students or parents to raise grades could be reported as malpractice and might lead to disqualification.
