Dear parent carer,

We hope your families got a break at Easter and that you are all keeping well.

Firstly, a reminder that our Behaviour for Learning Policy, approved by governors, states that parents will not be informed of detentions of up to 20 minutes after school. This is to allow staff to deal with low-grade incidents in a manageable fashion. We are restarting our school detention system on Monday. One of the issues that will lead to a detention is lateness, which has slipped lately. As I write, we had 85 lates today. Please do ensure that your child/children come to school on time.
