Dear parent/carer,

Starting back at school

You will have heard by now that the government has asked for a phased return of students to secondary schools starting on Monday 8th March.

Each student should have a test with a negative result before they start (although parents can refuse permission for their child to be tested - we hope that you won't do this as it increases the risk to others).

So, the plan is that we bring each year group for testing a day at a time as follows:

Day of Covid test	
Year 11	Monday 8th March
Year 10	Tuesday 9th March
Year 7	Wednesday 10th March
Year 9	Thursday 11th March
Year 8	Friday 12th March

On each of the days above, the year group will come in on a staggered basis (details to follow). Once each student has been tested, they will wait for their result and then go home. Then that year group will start back properly at school the following day:

Day that each year group starts back at school

Tuesday 9th March
Wednesday 10th March
Thursday 11th March
Friday 12th March
Monday 15th March

You can see that students will be home for some of the week beginning 8th March. When they are home, they will have work set for them on Google Classroom. However, there will be no online 'live lessons' as the teachers will need to be available to deliver lessons in school from Tuesday.





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Students should wear full school uniform. We will be switching back to the school day that we were running from September with the staggered start and end.
