Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope that you and your families have a wonderful half term holiday. It's been a busy half term and there has been a lot to tell you. At the time of writing, we're delighted to let you know that there have been no recorded cases of Covid 19 in our school this half term. We have been very cautious with our mask policy and will review our approach at the start of next half term.

SLT Detentions

We wrote to you recently to inform you that detentions have been reinstated following our return in April. We would now like to draw attention to a change regarding SLT detentions. Students used to receive such detentions when issues remain unresolved from earlier detentions or for serious incidents. In the past, this would take the form of a 2 hour detention after school. However, to better support our students, we shall be changing this to a parental meeting with a member of the Senior Leadership Team (SLT). These meetings will be held after school ends but on the school site (Covid-safe). If your child is identified as requiring this intervention, you will be contacted the week prior in order to arrange a suitable time. Your child should attend this meeting with you in full school uniform and bring their diary with them.

Examples of reasons for having an SLT detention include: missing a PAL or CTL detention; persistent truancy; damaging school property; failure of an SLT report or multiple low level behaviour incidents in one week.

We hope this change will continue to improve the behaviour of all students in our community and address issues which may be causing it. Thank you for your ongoing support on this
