Dear parent or carer,

COVID-19 vaccination

All young people aged 12 to 15 years are now being offered 2 doses of the vaccine 12 weeks apart.

The East London NHS Foundation Trust (ELFT) will be visiting your child's school on **Tuesday 15th** March 2022 to administer COVID-19 vaccinations.

ELFT will be running the clinic during school hours.

This vaccination will be free of charge and our highest priority is making it easy for children to access the vaccine as soon as possible.

The main purpose of the COVID-19 school age vaccination programme is to provide protection to the children who receive the vaccine and it may also help to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in the wider population.

During the vaccination delivery we will maintain a range of measures that we have in place to keep you safe from COVID-19.

ELFT will be carrying out a clinician-led screening process to ensure that any medical needs your child may have are accounted for, and that it is safe for your child to receive the vaccine. Please let the team know when completing the consent form of any medical needs your child may have, and if you have spoken to your child's consultant or GP regarding COVID-19 vaccination.

Dose 1 is available to all children, aged 12 years and over, who have not been vaccinated yet. Dose 2 is available to all children who have received Dose 1. There must be an interval of 12 weeks between the Dose 1 and Dose 2. If it has not been 12 weeks since their first dose, or if your child has received Dose 2 at another location, please do not submit a consent form.

Please ensure the form is completed and submitted by end of the day on 11th March 2022.

Children over the age of 16 do not need consent in order to receive the vaccine.

We cannot accept late consent forms, and therefore if you submit the completed form after the deadline your child may not be vaccinated in school.

Your child is unable to receive the vaccine if they have received a positive test for the Covid-19 virus in the past 12 weeks. If your child has recently tested positive for Covid-19 please do not submit a consent form.

Only children aged 12 or over are eligible for the vaccine. If your child is not aged <u>12 or over on the</u> <u>day of the session</u>, please do not submit a consent form.

If you would like your child to receive the vaccine, but they are unable to receive it at school, you can book an appointment at a clinic or mass vaccination centre via the National Booking System, which can be accessed by calling 119 or via the following link:
