Safeguarding Roadshow

There have recently been increasing concerns brought to our attention relating to safeguarding concerns across Newham, which may directly affect both our male and female students. This is a risk of our students being exposed to serious harm through Criminal Exploitation – CE, Child Sexual Exploitation – CSE and County Lines. Together with the Youth Charter and local partner agencies we are hosting an information session to help inform parents and carers regarding the support and information which is available.

The aim of this event is to share the signs to be aware of, and what agencies are doing to mitigate this phenomenon.

Our guest speaker, Geoff Thompson MBE FRSA DL – Founder and Chair of 'Youth Charter' a UK based international charity and United Nations Non-Governmental Organisation will be discussing the Social Coach Leadership Programme, which has been designed to assist parents and community leaders to build and strengthen relationships of trust, confidence and respect with our young people.

There will also be a number of agencies providing information and guidance around CSE, CE and County Lines, where you will have the opportunity to ask questions throughout and/or speak to the professionals at the end of the presentation. The Safeguarding Team from New Directions PRU and Tunmarsh School will be available throughout term time to speak with you, if you have any specific concerns relating to these matters, however, if you feel your child may be at risk from these issues right now, please contact the police directly.

It is important that at least one member of your family attend this event, so that you are able to identify and be aware of how you can better support and keep your sons / daughters or those in your care safe.

How to get to London Stadium Learning from Stratford – 20 min walk. When exiting the Stratford Station follow the signs to the Olympic Stadium.

Walk to the stadium past the Aquatics Centre. Cross the Bridge and turn to the left towards Gate E. MacLeod





Walk towards the Stadium Store and the Ticket offices.





To the left side of the store (before you get to Gate E) you will see the Community Marathon Track to your right. Please use the stairs to get down into the car park beside it.





Walk right towards the Club House entrance seen above. Press the doorbell for entry. If you get lost, call us on 020 8522 6128/7.

Another route from Pudding Mill lane DLR is quicker. You turn left out of the station, take a right along the Loop Road and then go up the stairs to Gate E (with track on the right). Follow directions above past the WHU Store.
