I am writing to inform you that some National Education Union members of staff are potentially taking industrial action next week on Wednesday 18th and Thursday 19th November, 2020.

Staff members are taking the action "in opposition to unacceptable impact on working conditions of proposed extension of the school to 12 form entry." The school and Local Authority are working with the staff in an effort to resolve this dispute.
