- A personal statement of not more than 100 words should be provided (a typed version if possible) to be circulated to all parents if there is a need to go to ballot.
- This form must be returned to the school office on or before the closing date.

The closing date to receive the nomination form with your personal statement is <u>10</u> <u>am on Wednesday, 18 September 2019.</u>

If there are more candidates than vacancies then a ballot will be organised and ballot papers will be sent to all parents with candidates personal statements.
