Home reading and comprehension notes for parents/students:

- There are different topics in the separate folders so that students can pick which topic engages them the most.
- The folders with UR (unconfident readers) are for students who may find some of the other comprehension questions a little more challenging.
- In the separate folders there may be different comprehension documents labelled UR (unconfident readers), M (somewhere between hesitant and confident), and CR (confident readers). These are differentiated for the different student abilities, however, students should challenge themselves.
- In the different folders, you will also find the answers to the comprehension questions, usually after the questions which have the blank spaces to answer. Please use the answers only as a guideline **after** the students have attempted to answer the questions for themselves.
- If you want to, you can print out the documents, however just reading the documents and writing the answers to the question will help with reading and inferences.
- There are also vocabulary sheets attached in every folder linked to the topic, which will enable students to learn new words and terminology.
- It will also help if students read aloud the reading material.
- The 'Lexia reading and comprehension' folder also has other excellent reading material.
- There is also 'At home tips for parents', which has tips you may find useful in helping your child with reading at home.
