## **RE: School Sports Day Year 9 & 10 2021 - Friday 2nd July 2021**

I am writing to advise you that we will be hosting our annual Sports Day on Friday 2nd July 2021 at the Cricklefields Stadium in Ilford. The day will be split into two sessions with Year 9 and 10 events in the morning and Year 7 and 8 in the afternoon.

All Year 9 and 10 students participating in the events or spectating will be expected to arrive at Cricklefields Stadium at 8:20am.

In the event of very poor weather leading to the cancellation of the event we will notify parents and students via the school website and parent mail. Due to covid precautionary measures we cannot allow parents to come and watch the events. Students should bring face coverings with them. Phones should not be taken to the event unless they are vital for student travel. If phones are required for this reason they should be switched off and not seen or heard. Phones will be confiscated if they are seen or heard and returned on Monday 5th July.

Dismissal: 11.25am

### **Uniform**

Students must wear a full Little Ilford School PE kit as stated on p. 32 of the Student Diary - no other clothing is permitted to be worn. The PE kit consists of; black and red polo shirt with school badge, black and red shorts or bottoms, black and red socks. In addition, students have been given a self-designed white t-shirt to wear for the day to show their support for their team. This can be worn instead of their usual LIS PE jersey.

### **Attendance**

It is compulsory that your child attends on the day, even if they are not down to compete in any of the events. Any non-attendance will be marked as an unauthorised absence. Students who are not competing in an event are there to support the success and participation of all students within their form class. If your child is unwell please report their absence in the usual way.
