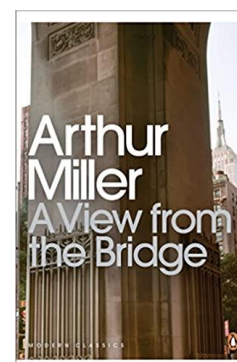
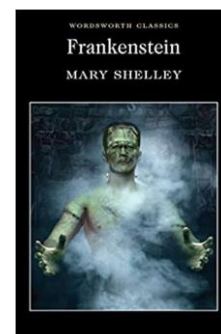
As you are aware, your child will need to cover a range of literature texts in English this year.
