Return to school Lateral Flow testing

In line with government requirements, in order for staff, students and families to be as safe as possible, it is important that we carry out lateral flow tests at school. Students will be tested three times in school, with a 3-5 day interval between each test. Each year group is invited to school for testing on the first day and will then return home. You will receive a timetable for when your child's form group is expected in (in full uniform). On the following day, they will be expected to attend school via their usual gate and Covid staggered start times. You will only be contacted if the result proves positive. Click here for guidance on how the test is carried out.

In order to test your child in school, we must have your specific consent. Please complete the online form to give this consent - this has been sent to you via ParentMail.

Students will not be prevented from coming to school if you do not consent to testing, but we would urge you to give consent to help us maintain a safe environment for all and reduce the risk of the virus being spread by people who do not have symptoms. Additional testing will take place when students are in school.


