Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very proud of how much our school culture continues to evolve and improve. As we continue on our journey towards excellence, we want every student to develop a strong sense of personal pride, independence, and responsibility - to do the right thing even when nobody is watching.

To support this, we will be ensuring our uniform policy is being followed from Monday 03 November 2025.

From this date:

- Students must be in full, correct uniform from the moment they arrive at the school gates in the morning until they leave the premises at the end of the day.
- If any part of a student's uniform is incorrect, they will receive a behaviour point immediately.
- Every member of staff will issue a behaviour point if they see a student in incorrect uniform.
- Jewellery (including nose piercings) will be confiscated. Refusal to hand over prohibited items will be escalated in line with our policy.

Banned / Prohibited Items

Please remind your child that the following items and styles are **not permitted**:

- No skinny fit clothing (e.g., no lycra or stretchy material)
- No hoodies.
- No caps.
- Hijabs must have the student's designated Year group ribbon.
- No visible makeup (including coloured nails and fake eyelashes).
- No jewellery (including nose piercings).
- No non-natural hair colour.
- No trainers (even if they appear to look like shoes).

Blazer Expectations

Blazers must be worn at all times and in all areas of the school, except for the following:

- Astroturf
- MUGA
- Classrooms (with teacher's permission)

Students are expected to wear their blazer correctly from the moment they enter the school grounds until they leave.
